

Health & Safety Tips for Property Viewings

To ensure a safe and comfortable visit, please observe the following safety guidelines while viewing the property:

1. Watch Your Step

Be aware of uneven floors, steps, – especially in older properties or during renovations. Use handrails where available.

2. Mind Low Ceilings & Door Frames

Some areas may have lower-than-average ceilings or beams. Please take care to avoid injury.

3. Wet or Slippery Surfaces

If it has been raining, floors (especially tiles or wooden decking) may be slippery. Please walk carefully.

4. Children Supervision

Please keep children supervised at all times. Some areas may not be child-safe. Garden pond, swimming pool, well etc.

5. Restricted Areas

Some parts of the property may be off-limits (e.g., attic, garage, or outbuildings). Please respect any signage or guidance from the agent. Always ask before opening doors, drawers or cupboards

6. Use of Stairs

Take extra care on staircases. If you feel unsteady or need assistance, please let the agent know.

7. Fire Exits and Emergency Procedures

In case of emergency, follow the guidance of the agent. Please take note of exit points when you arrive.

8. Trip Hazards

Be cautious of trailing wires, rugs, or loose flooring that may pose a tripping risk.

9. Allergies or Sensitivities

Be aware that pets may live at the property, or that cleaning products have been used recently.

10. Illness Precautions

If you are unwell or have symptoms of any contagious illness, please reschedule your visit.

11. Be careful what you say

Many homes have home security camera around the property which may pick up conversations around the property or as you arrive/leave. Be mindful of the conversations being held

If there are any specific issues relevant to this property then you will be advised at the commencement of viewing.
